



Biographical Note

Andrew Mack is director of the Human Security Report Project at Simon Fraser University in Vancouver, Canada, and a faculty member of the university's new School for International Studies. He previously directed the Human Security Centre at the University of British Columbia where the Project was located until its move to Simon Fraser University in May 2007.

Prior to joining UBC, Professor Mack was a visiting professor at the Program on Humanitarian Policy and Conflict Research at Harvard University (2001) and spent two and a half years as director of the Strategic Planning Unit in the Executive Office of Secretary-General Kofi Annan at the United Nations (1998–2001).

Professor Mack held the Chair in International Relations at the Institute of Advanced Study at the Australian National University (ANU) (1991-98), was the director of the ANU's Peace Research Centre (1985-91) and was senior research fellow in the ANU's Strategic and Defence Studies Centre (1984-85).

He has held research and teaching positions at Flinders University (Adelaide, Australia); the London School of Economics; the Copenhagen Peace Research Institute; the Richardson Institute for Peace and Conflict Research in London; the University of California at Berkeley, Irvine and San Diego; the University of Hawaii; Fudan University in Shanghai and the International University of Japan.

His pre-academic career included six years in the Royal Air Force (as an engineer and pilot); two and a half years in Antarctica as a meteorologist and deputy base commander; a year as a diamond prospector in Sierra Leone and two years with the BBC's World Service producing the current affairs program, *The World Today*.

Professor Mack has written and edited some 11 monographs and books and his 50-plus scholarly articles have appeared in a wide range of journals, including *World Politics*, *The Washington Quarterly*, *British Journal of International Studies*, *World Policy*, *Foreign Policy*, *Comparative Politics*, *The Journal of Conflict Resolution*, *Journal of Peace Research*, *Politics*, *Security Dialogue*, *Arms Control*, *Asian Survey*, *Australian Journal of International Affairs* and the *Pacific Review*.

He has also published widely in the mainstream print media, including the *International Herald Tribune*, *The Economist*, *The Guardian*, *Le Monde Diplomatique*, *Newsday*, *Yomiuri Shimbun*, *The Australian*, *The Financial Review*, *The Sydney Morning Herald*, *Corriere Della Sierra*, *Far Eastern Economic Review*, *The Japan Times*, *New Scientist*, *The Bulletin*, *The New Zealand Herald*, *The Christian Science Monitor*, *The Globe and Mail*, *Ottawa Citizen*, *The Nation* and the *South China Morning*.

Professor Mack has received research grants from the MacArthur, Ford, W. Alton Jones and Rockefeller Foundations, and from the United Nations University, the Social Science Research Council (UK), and the governments of Australia, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, Canada and the UK.
